Instruction for installing and setting up LINA software

Goal

The goal of this software is to protect scientific data from the member of this institute (permanent and non-permanent) stored on computers (laptop or desktop) which have been bought with public funding. This is an professional obligation to protect the result of the science of this institute Personal data can be saved too but they should be clearly identified by an explicit folder name (private, personal,...)

Installing

Operating systems MacOSX, windows et Linux are supported

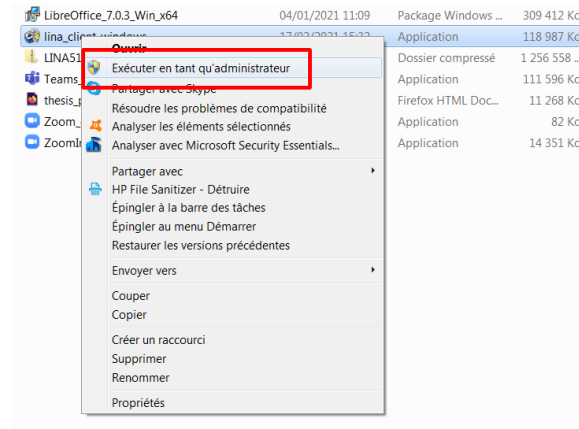
Preset

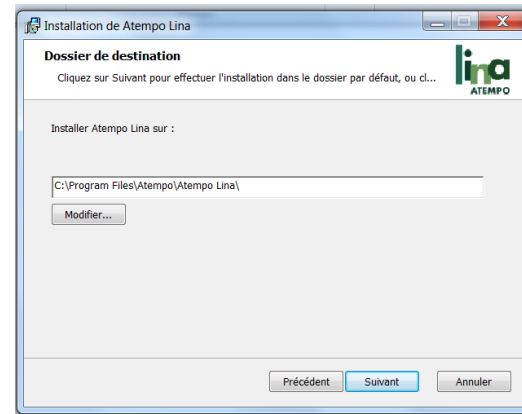
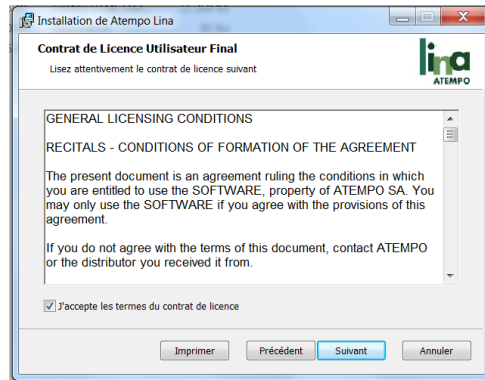
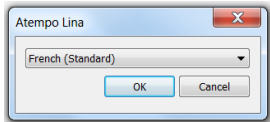
installation step (windows)

After downloading the file needed for your operating system, execute it as administrator.



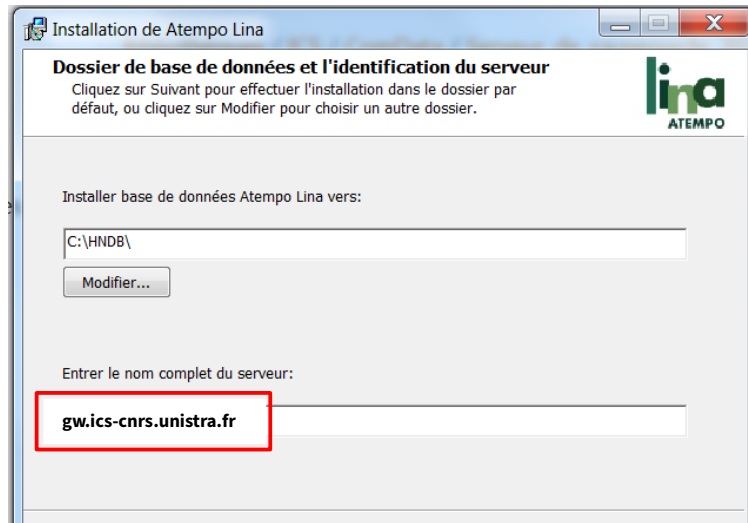
Installation walk-through

Chose language, accept licence, select destination folder.

Entrer the server adress for the institut **gw.ics-cnrs.unistra.fr**



Once the software installed, you have to ask for authorization to connect, send your request to the following address.

`sauvegarde@ics-cnrs.unistra.fr`

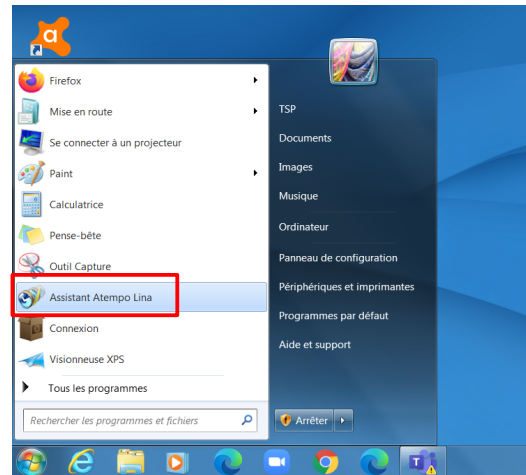

Once installation done, the software is already active (after authorization), but you have to reboot your computer (optional) if you want to activate all features.

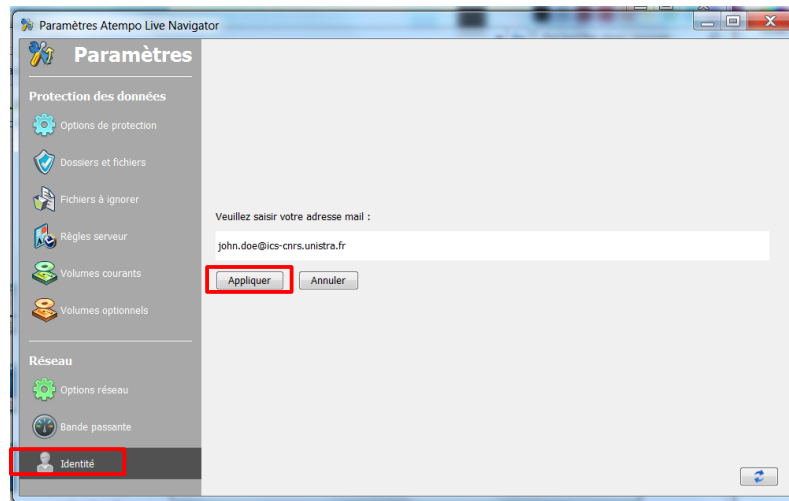
You can now access the program through the menu to its setup, look for

Assistant Atempo Lina .

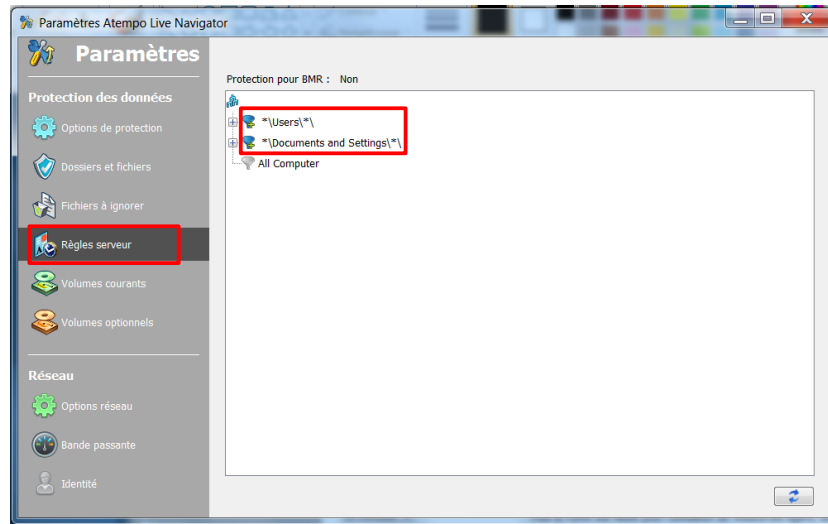
Start the program Assistant Atempo Lina and select the button **Parameters**.
Then **Identité**, enter your email and **Apply**.

Default template is no directory is include by default (grey).

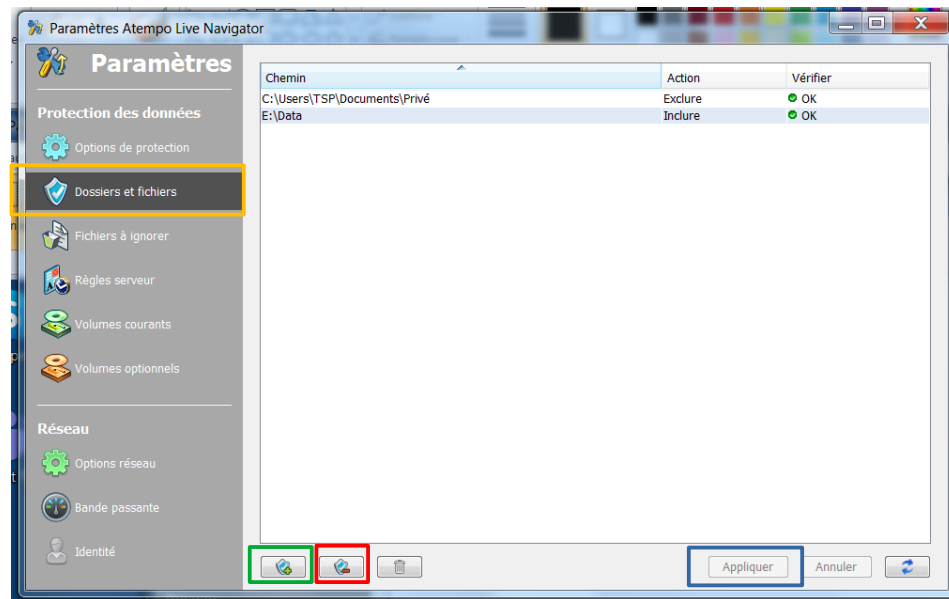

You can select the directories and files you wish to protect you can **add** or **remove** directory from the perimeter of the protection. Once done don't forget to

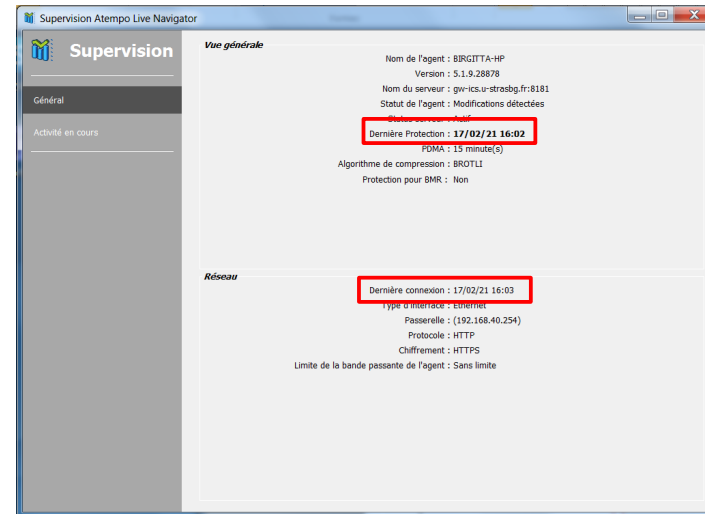
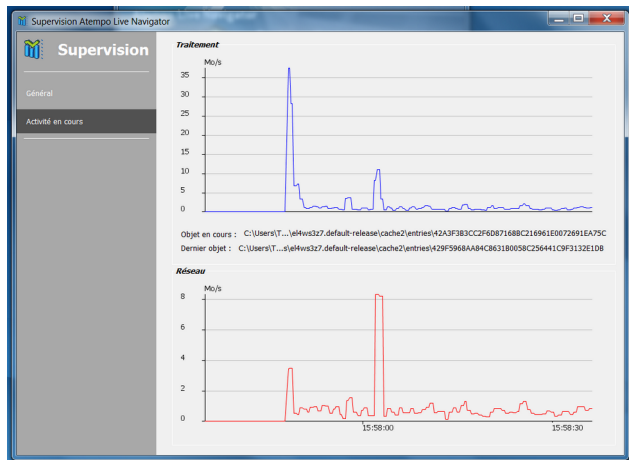
